RESOLUTION GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION
TO SELL SURPLUS PROPERTY


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington, has previously declared the existing lot and building sitate at 930 North Main Street, East Wenatchee, Washington, to be surplus property for District purposes; and

WHEREAS, it would appear desirable and prudent that said lot and property be sold on terms consistent with the best sale provisions of the current real estate market; NOW, THEREFORE


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington, that the Manager shall be directed to publish Notice of Intention to Sell, once each week for three consecutive weeks, in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation within the District, and the date of last publication shall be at least twenty (20) days, but not more than thirty (30) days before date of sale. The notice shall fully describe the property and state the time and place at which it will be sold, and provide for minimum bid terms of not less than **fifteen (15%)** per cent down, and the balance to be paid in monthly installments, which, together with interest and principal, shall pay said balance in not more than **fifteen (15)** years. Said notice shall further reserve the right to reject any and all bids and shall state the minimum bid to be not less than ninety (90%) per cent of the appraised value of said property.
