

RESOLUTION NO. 181

AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE TWO PUMPS FROM CHELAN COUNTY PUD

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has had an unusual growth in building East of Nile Avenue and the growth was such that it became no longer possible to supply water demands in that area, the District was faced with the inevitable decision not to sell meters to potential or future builders in the above area and,

WHEREAS, after a careful study by the Superintendent of the District, it was determined that a booster pump could be installed at 5th and Nile Avenue, together with approximately 1,500 feet of pipe, looping the dead end systems on Nile and Stark avenue and,

WHEREAS, the District has learned that two fifteen (15) horsepower In-Line Centrifugal Pumps are available for sale by the Chelan County PUD, Wenatchee, Washington, and

WHEREAS, it has been negotiated between the District and Chelan County PUD for purchase of said pumps for a price of \$200.00 for each pump.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington, that the said pumps be purchased for said price.

ADOPTED, this 25th day of April 1977, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
