A POLICY ON HIRING NEW EMPLOYEES



WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District having for a period of years frequently hired persons who were related to other employees, officers or commissioners, and said practice now appearing to be ill-advised as it may create an appearance of unfairness, and,


WHEREAS, it being deemed in the best interest of the East Wenatchee Water District to change this policy and create a clear statement of intent for future personnel decisions, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington, beginning on May 2, 1977 the East Wenatchee Water District will not employ more than one member of a family at any one time. Exceptions to this policy will only be made by the Commissioners after a recommendation by the Manager that an exceptional case has arisen. Before such exception will be made, a full and public disclosure of the applicant's qualifications will be made and an opportunity afforded to the general public to submit applications for the vacancy.

ADOPTED, this 16 day of May 1977, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
