

RESOLUTION NO. 237

AUTHORIZING BASIC RATE INCREASE FOR WATER USAGE

WHEREAS, the present basic rate for water service supplied to basic single family residence and other users within the District has not been changed since December 30, 1975, and

WHEREAS, the District has been advised by their financial consultant and their engineers that revenues from the present rate do not conform to the 1.40 bond coverage requirement as called for in Resolution No. 146 dated the 13th day of July 1976, and

WHEREAS, it is apparent that a water rate increase is necessary and must be implemented in order to meet the 1.40 coverage and to continue to provide service to present customers as well as future users of the East Wenatchee Water District, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have reviewed alternative courses of action, with all of the District's advisors and considered all elements necessary,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington as follows: The basic rate for a single family residence shall be changed from the present rate of \$5.75 per month to \$7.00 per month. Said rate increase is to become effective on May 1, 1978.
