

AUTHORIZING BASIC RATE INCREASE FOR USERS OF ROCK ISLAND

WHEREAS, the present basic rate for water service supplied to basic single family residence to the users of Rock Island is not adequate for the District to continue to operate that system under the present contract with the Town, and

WHEREAS, a balloon payment of \$20,500 is due on November 1, 1986 to retire the present debt service on outstanding water revenue bonds, and

WHEREAS, the District has compiled figures taken over a six month average of the costs to operate the Rock Island system verses the cost to operate the District's system, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest to the users of East Wenatchee that they should not be helping subsidize the users in Rock Island, and

WHEREAS, it is apparent that a water rate increase is necessary and must be implimented now to continue to serve the Town of Rock Island,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington as follows: The basic rate for a single family residence shall be changed from the present rate of \$7.00 per month to \$9.50 per month. Said rate increase is to become effective on December 1, 1978.

ADOPTED this 23rd day of October 1978, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
