
AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 159 -- RAISING PETTY CASH LIMIT

WHEREAS, the Petty Cash requirements for the ordinary transactions of business for the District has substantially increased the past three years, and

WHEREAS, the present fund is not sufficient or adequate to meet the current needs and the Manager has recommended an increase from the present amount of \$150.00 to \$500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington, 98801 that the Manager is hereby authorized to increase the Petty Cash limit to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) immediately and to remain at said amount until further action maybe taken and subject to vouchering for replenishment on a monthly basis.
