

RESOLUTION NO. 297

AWARDING CONTRACT BID FOR PANGBORN RESERVOIR

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District having complied with R.C.W. 57.08.050 in calling for bids to construct a one million gallon steel reservoir to be called Reservoir No. 8, and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications were written calling for separate bid schedules to include the following:

Schedule I - Steel tank & painting


Schedule II - Ringwall - site work and access road

WHEREAS, the District received six (6) bids on the reservoir or Schedule I and received four (4) bids on Schedule II, and


WHEREAS, the apparent low bidder on Schedule I was Pittsburgh-Demoines Steel Company, Bellevue, Washington in the amount of \$172,890 and Selland Construction Company, Wenatchee, Washington was the low bidder on Schedule II in the amount of \$58,379, and

WHEREAS, the District's engineer having reviewed all the bids with the Manager and has made his recommendation that the two low bids be accepted by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, subject to approval of said bids by the Department of Social & Health Services, Olympia, Washington.
