DECLARING SURPLUS EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District having updated the District's distribution system considerably the past five years and,

WHEREAS, the manager and superintendent having discussed with the Board of Commissioners the District's surplus equipment on hand and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the following items are no longer needed within the District or they have become worn due to the years in service:


1. 1952 Allis Chalmers Grader - 4 cylinder - Serial #2363
2. One 7½ H.P. Peerless Turbine Pump - Serial #183694 with 40' 4" column and US Motor, 1800 R.P.M.
3. Two - 10 H.P. Centrifical Jacuzzi pumps - 3,500 R.P.M.
4. One - 40 H.P. motor, 3,600 R.P.M.
5. A Flow-way 5 H.P. Submersible pump, Serial #69-4865 - 104 G.P.M. at 120' Head - 3,450 R.P.M.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District hereby declare the above named items as surplus and further authorize the manager to call for bids and dispose of same, according to the statutes set forth.
