

RESOLUTION NO. 327

AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF 90 POUND PAVING BREAKER

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District does not have at the present time a device that will enable the District to install pipe under an asphalt road and,


WHEREAS, on several occasions, the District must seek assistance from a company that specializes in this type of work, which is very expensive, or rent this special piece of equipment from another entity, which is not always convenient and,

WHEREAS, on some instances it is not permissible to cut or dig a trench in certain asphalt roads, thereby making it virtually impossible to install a water meter and rendering service for a customer who has requested a water service and,

WHEREAS, the District has received two quotes that will enable District personnel to provide this needed service and after reviewing the quotes submitted by Stanley Tool Company and Fray Equipment Company, both of Seattle, it is believed that the lessor of the two quotes, Fray Equipment Company, in the amount of \$1,350.00 plus sales tax, will adequately serve the Districts needs.


