

RESOLUTION NO. 330

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 312 "CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP OF LID #7  
from  
GREATER WENATCHEE IRRIGATION DISTRICT  
to  
EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT"

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District, on October 5th, 1981, assumed full ownership of a domestic water system from the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District and,

WHEREAS, parts of the agreement was outlined that any customer seeking to connect to the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District, LID #7 system, would pay an assessment fee of \$1,103.00, of which would be turned over to the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation System to help retire the debt service which had been paid in full by them in the amount of \$41,086.66 and,


WHEREAS, after several discussions and meetings between the two entities and to establish a fair and equitable solution regarding the assessment fees, it was agreed that the assessment fee would be charged only to those who were not on the original assessment rolls or those customers outside the LID #7 boundaries and,

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District will continue to connect future customers to that system upon request, or as long as that system is capable of handling the added growth, those monies collected will be turned over to Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District until the East Wenatchee Water District is notified that the debt service has been paid in full.

ADOPTED, this 9th day of January 1984, by the Commissioners of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
