

RESOLUTION NO. 331

ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR LEAKS ON CUSTOMERS SIDE OF METER

WHEREAS, an excessive water leak will occur from time to time on the customers side of the water meter and,

WHEREAS, by previous guidelines as adopted by the East Wenatchee Water District, this leak becomes the responsibility of the tenant or the homeowner and,


WHEREAS, an intensive survey has been conducted of different towns, cities and water districts on how a situation of this same nature is handled and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that various entities have different methods for this charge, while some do not allow any compensation and,


WHEREAS, it is believed to be in the best interest of both the customer and the East Wenatchee Water District to mutually agree upon a compensation that is fair and equitable.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that on future water leaks that appear on the customers side of the water meter, the Water District will notify the customer as soon as the leak is detected; the customer will be instructed to make the necessary repairs and the total excess usage bill will be reduced 25% of the total amount of said bill.
