

RESOLUTION NO. 338

AUTHORIZING CHARGE FOR TURN-ON: TURN-OFF AT CUSTOMER'S REQUEST

WHEREAS, The East Wenatchee Water District, from time to time receives requests from certain customers within the District to turn off their water and,

WHEREAS, these customers generally move South or to other parts of the country during the winter months and,


WHEREAS, the District is put to considerable expense and disrupts the work flow when a request of this nature is requested, as it is necessary to make a trip to the residence, read the meter and process a final bill and,

WHEREAS, it is believed that this is a request that is above and beyond the service that is provided to the customers and therefore it is further believed that the District should be compensated for the expense involved.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that all future requests for "turn-on; turn-off" of water meters by the customer, as mentioned above, the customer will be charged a fee of \$5.00 for each trip made to the residence.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions or rate policies inconsistent with this Resolution No. 338 and prior to this date are hereby revoked.
