RESENDING RESOLUTION NO. 128 AND RE-ESTABLISHING A SERVICE CHARGE ON  
"NON-SUFFICIENT FUND CHECKS"

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District is a public entity that must receive a large amount of personal checks from the general public in paying their water bills and,

WHEREAS, a certain amount of these checks are returned by the banks showing insufficient and,


WHEREAS, the cost of processing these checks to the District is costly and unfair to the other regular customers of the District and the present service charge is \$5.00 is no longer appropriate to cover the work hours involved and,

WHEREAS, having checked with various other utilities both locally as well as State wide and determined that \$10.00 appears to be the minimum charge being assessed to customers who's checks return.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that effective immediately, all checks returned from various banks because of non-sufficient funds, shall be assessed a charge of \$10.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all Resolutions or rate policies inconsistent with this Resolution and prior to this date are hereby abolished and/or revoked.
