

RESOLUTION NO. 383

AUTHORIZING INCREASE IN EXCESS WATER USAGE

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District adopted a new five year Comprehensive Plan in the fall of 1989, and in that Plan, several items have been identified as deficiencies in the distribution system whereby steps should be taken to correct those deficiencies and,

WHEREAS, additional revenues can be generated by initiating a rate increase on the excess water consumed by the District's users and,

WHEREAS, in the judgement of the Board of Commissioners, the District is required to make certain additions to and betterments and extensions of its existing water supply and distribution system and,


WHEREAS, after much consideration and advise from both legal counsel and the District's engineer, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the East Wenatchee Water District to increase the excess water rate, thereby allowing the District to pursue the Comprehensive Plan, as adopted previously.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that effective January 1st, 1991, the rate for all excess water used above 600 cubic feet per month, shall be \$.55 for each 100 cubic feet consumed.

ADOPTED, this 2nd day of January 1991, by the Board of commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
