

RESOLUTION NO. 390

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO INSTALL APPROXIMATELY 160 FEET
OF 12" DUCTILE IRON PIPE

WHEREAS, the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT has discussed with the Public Works Department the installation of 48" storm drain pipe the County is proposing to install in the general vicinity of 32nd and N.W. Cascade Streets and,

WHEREAS, the existing 8" domestic water main which serves the Water District customers North of this area is in conflict with the placement of the proposed storm pipe and,

WHEREAS, the Water District has been notified, by letter, dated September 3rd, 1991 from the Public Works Department that their plans are to install said pipe within a time period that makes matters very complicated in the Water District's schedule to have the project engineered and specifications prepared for competitive bid and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be cost effective to the Water district to proceed with the installation of said pipe with District personnel and install the necessary valves and fittings.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, that Resolution No. 390 is hereby declared an emergency and further authorizes the manager to proceed with District personnel for the installation of said pipe and complete the project in a timely manner.
