

**RESOLUTION NO. 423**

**ESTABLISHING A NEW METER INSTALLATION METHOD  
IN SUBDIVISIONS**

WHEREAS, it has been the policy of the East Wenatchee Water District in previous years to install all meter boxes in subdivisions where new development occurs and set the meter boxes to proper grade, as staked by the developer's engineer, and


WHEREAS, the District now requires the developer or its contractor to install the service water line from the new water main installed by the developer or its contractor in the street to the property corner where the water meter is located, and

WHEREAS, from previous experience, there appears to be a working congestion between the contractor and Water District personnel striving to accomplish the job in a timely manner and therefore the productivity of work between the contractor and Water District personnel is congested, and


WHEREAS, the District has researched and established a new innovation of installing water meters in future subdivisions to become effective in January 1995, whereby the installation will consist of a round eighteen inch (18) PVC pipe to replace the present concrete boxes now used and will require the contractor or its developer set the PVC pipe to an established grade on the property corners as staked by the engineer and connect the necessary plumbing so water meters can be installed inside the PVC pipe, and

WHEREAS, Water District personnel will deliver to the job site, at no expense to the developer or its contractor, all new applications for the meter installations and the developer or the contractor will be required to provide the necessary plumbing, per water District standards, at the developers expense to complete the installation, whether it be a single meter or a double box installation.
