RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE  
DISTRICT'S PETTY CASH FUND.


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District, by previous Resolution, established a petty cash fund in the amount of \$500.00 for the District's use, and

WHEREAS, having re-evaluated that amount to be used by the District for miscellaneous expenses, as needed from time to time, is not sufficient to meet those needs in certain circumstances and it is deemed to be in the best interest of the District to increase that amount to \$1,000.00 so the District will have sufficient funds to operate within the statutes.

NOW THEREFOR, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that the Petty Cash Fund be increased from the current \$500.00 to \$1,000 so as to comply with the paragraph set fourth above.
