

RESOLUTION NO. 460

ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON THE SALE OF WATER METERS IN THE PANGBORN AIRPORT AREA.

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has been contacted by various property owners in the vicinity of Pangborn Airport regarding the availability of water to develop their property, which is presently zoned industrial, and

WHEREAS, the District has had its consulting engineer perform a hydraulic analysis on the water system facilities serving the industrial area in the vicinity of Pangborn Airport which is depicted on the attached map, hereto as Exhibit A, and

WHEREAS, the results of the consulting engineers hydraulic analysis indicates that the existing booster pump stations and existing small diameter water mains in Grant Road is no longer capable of serving additional water meters to this area and still maintain the current level of service, (including without limitation, fire protection) to the existing customers, and


WHEREAS, the majority of the existing system capacity has been committed to current connections and properties within a Local Improvements District formed by the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation, and

NOW THEREFOR, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, hereby deem it to be in the best interest of the District and its customers that are currently being served in the area depicted on the Map, attached as "Exhibit A", to establish a moratorium on the sale of water meters for any future use until such time as a larger water main, booster pump station, and other necessary improvements are installed by others to the current water system to meet such future demands, to be effective as of the date of this resolution.

ADOPTED, this 1st day of May, 1997, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
