**Rescinding No. 339**  
**Increase Commissioners Compensation**

WHEREAS, the State Legislature changes the per diem rate of compensation for water district commissioners from time to time; and

WHEREAS, it is impractical to revise the District's resolutions relating to the ~~the~~ *OK* compensation of its Water Commissioners each time the State Legislature changes the per diem compensation to be paid each commissioner of a water district; and

WHEREAS, the affairs of the district shall be managed by the Board of Commissioners composed of three members, they shall receive expenses necessarily incurred in attending meetings or otherwise engaged in district business. The Board may provide, by resolution payment of compensation to each Commissioner at a rate of up to seventy dollars (\$70.00).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT authorizes the increase the payment for compensation to each member.

WHEREAS, the maximum compensation paid water commissioners is from time to time established by the State Legislature and,


WHEREAS, a district may establish compensation for its Commissioners by resolution up to the maximum allowable under law.
