RESOLUTION ACCEPTING SIX-YEAR COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District is required by the State Board of Health, under WAC 246-290-100, to prepare a comprehensive plan for its water system every six years, and

WHEREAS, the District is required to prepare a comprehensive plan which is consistent with and concurrent to Douglas County's Growth Management Plan for the Greater East Wenatchee Urban Area, and


WHEREAS, the District's Engineer has prepared a new comprehensive plan for the water system and said plan meets the requirements as identified by the Department of Health and complies with Washington State Board of Health's regulations for Group A public water systems, and

WHEREAS, the District has complied with the State Environment Policy Act (SEPA) and has declared a Declaration of Non-Significance for said plan and has published said notice as required by State law, and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive plan has been reviewed and approved by the Board of Commissioners and the District's Manager, and

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District approves, accepts and ratifies the Comprehensive Plan; and adopts and enters a Declaration of Non-significance under and pursuant to the terms of SEPA.
