ADOPTION OF WATER EFFICIENCY GOALS

WHEREAS, the District is required by the State Department of Health to adopt water efficiency rules and goals, and

WHEREAS, the rule requires public notification of said goals, and

WHEREAS, the District has put said notice on its website, and

WHEREAS, the District had its first public meeting for input on January 2, 2008 and the second meeting for public input will be on January 16, 2008, and


WHEREAS, the goals are listed as follows:

1. Reduce the unaccounted for water by 1 percent to 2 percent
2. Reduce per connection use by 2 percent to 3 percent
3. Promote public education and awareness of water conservation issues, and

WHEREAS, the District had previously adopted these rules and goals in our 2006 six-year Comprehensive Water System Plan, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District that these water efficiency rules and goals are formally accepted.
