

**RESOLUTION NO. 757**

**AWARD JOHNSTON RESERVOIR**

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District pursuant to R.C.W. 57.08.050 called for bids in connection with the Johnston Reservoir generally described as follows:

Work to be performed includes construction of a 1MG AWWA D100 welded steel reservoir, site grading, underground utilities, drainage systems, electrical and controls and final surface restoration.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared by the District's Engineer for the above-described project and the successful contractor will furnish all the necessary equipment and material to complete each job as called for in the project contract documents, and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2021, the District received five bids to install said facilities as follows:


T-Bailey	\$2,104,160.70
KRCI	\$2,306,329.73
CBI Services	\$2,393,430.00
Hurst Construction	\$2,425,725.06
Rotschy	\$2,585,140.49

WHEREAS, having reviewed all the bid documents with the District's Engineer, it appears that all bids are responsive bids and therefore it is recommended by the District's Engineer that the lowest responsible bid be awarded to T-Bailey for the amount of \$2,104,160.70, and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that the lowest responsible bid from T-Bailey in the amount of two million, one hundred four thousand, one hundred sixty dollars and seventy cents be hereby accepted and a contract for the project will be executed with T-Bailey of Anacortes, Washington.

BE IT ALSO HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, the General Manager is authorized to do all acts necessary to effectuate the Resolution adopted herein.
