RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMPLOYEES BONUS PAYMENT

On motion duly made by CARL GUSSMAN, seconded by L. H. FRAJBY, and unanimously passed, the following resolution was adopted by the Board of Commissioners of East Wenatchee Water District.

WHEREAS, it is considered in the best interests of the Water District to encourage, stimulate, and properly recognize employee faithfulness and longevity of service with proper vacation and bonus incentives, and

WHEREAS, it would appear that any employee of more than ten years service is deserving of vacation time in addition to any salary bonus awards,

NOW, THEREFORE, It is Hereby Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District that any employee with ten years or more continuous service shall be entitled to annual bonus awards as may be determined by the Board from time to time, after a review of the service rendered of any such employee, and consideration of all other circumstances of the Water District.

Be It Further Resolved That, consistent with the foregoing general standards of employment longevity and service, there shall be available to any such employees annual vacation periods with pay, in an amount of not less than two weeks, and that such additional vacation periods may be allowed as from time to time may seem proper.

Any employee shall be entitled to these compensations and awards upon the termination of their service by their own volition,

or by death or illness.
