

RESOLUTION NO. 81

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has certain real property located within the boundaries of the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District, and

WHEREAS, said real property owned by the East Wenatchee Water District is not presently devoted to or cannot reasonably be utilized for farming or agriculture purposes and will not benefit in any manner from being included in the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District, and

WHEREAS, such real property is used for well, reservoir and purposes exclusively peculiar to the business of the East Wenatchee Water District, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that this Board of Commissioners should petition the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District to exclude that property belonging to the East Wenatchee Water District lying within the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District boundaries, being further described as follows:

Tax 3: Commence at the west quarter corner of Section 1, TWP. 22 N., Range 20 E.W.M., Douglas County Washington, and run East on the North line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 620 feet to the true point of beginning; thence continue East on said line for 100 feet; thence South 100 feet; thence West 100 feet; thence North 100 feet to the true point of beginning.

TAX 9: Commence at the West quarter corner of Sec. 1, Twp. 22 N, Range 20 E.W.M., Douglas County, Wash., and run East on the North line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section for 620 feet; thence South 100 feet to the true point of beginning; thence East 100 feet; thence North 100 feet to the E line of said subdivision; thence East on said North line to the NE corner of said subdivision; thence S 396 feet; thence West on a line 396 feet south of and parallel to said North line of said subdivision for 500 feet; thence northwesterly to the point of beginning.

Dated this 28th day of July, 1960, and adopted by the Board of Commissioners, East Wenatchee Water District at their regular meeting on this date, by the unanimous vote of all the Commissioners.
