

RESOLUTION NO. 97

WHEREAS, a specialized course in local government accounting will be offered during the 1967 school year at the Community College level as a part of the adult evening education program, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this course, which was developed through a cooperative effort by the State Auditor and Superintendent of Public Instruction, is to provide professional assistance in this specialized field by centering attention on the State Constitution, the laws of the State of Washington and the double-entry self-balancing fund concept of general governmental accounting as recommended by the Municipal Finance Officers Association, and


WHEREAS, it has been well established by the Division of Municipal Corporations, on the basis of legal advice obtained from the Attorney General's Office, that a municipality does have the authority to assist in paying the expense of such a short, specialized course on behalf of its employees, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, that the District will benefit considerably as the result of its employees taking said specialized short courses, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the East Wenatchee Water District Commissioners that the tuition for said short course be paid in full from funds of the East Wenatchee Water District, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT future short courses, where directly beneficial to the Water District, be paid from District funds.
