

RESOLUTION NO. 100

RESOLUTION RE FRONT FOOTAGE ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS the East Wenatchee Water District deems it prudent, necessary and advisable to adopt a uniform policy of assessment on front footage extensions of watermain where service has previously been made by private line, and

WHEREAS this matter has been thoroughly studied and reported on to the Board of Commissioners by the staff and employees of the East Wenatchee Water District, and recommendations on this situation have been made to the Board, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington, as follows:

That at such times as a user or customer within the Water District service area requests water service to a meter at a point remote from his property which will be served beyond the meter by his own service line, but which may be served at some future time by a regular main line of the East Wenatchee Water District, then at such time the owner of the property to be served shall enter into an undertaking agreeing to the subsequent assessment of his property at the prevailing front footage rate at such time as the main extension may be made to serve his property, and provided further that at such time as the main may be extended the District shall assume the costs of moving the meter from its original place to the subsequent nearest point of access to the user's property.

ADOPTED this 27th day of August, 1967, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District at a regular meeting thereof.
