

RESOLUTION NO. 128

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SERVICE CHARGE ON CHECKS

§

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District is a public body and must necessarily receive a large amount of personal checks from the general public, and

WHEREAS, an unfortunate percentage of these checks are returned one or more times by the banks showing insufficient funds, and

WHEREAS, the cost of processing these checks to the District is disproportionately high and unfair to the other regular customers of the District and a service charge should be made consistent with that applied by various other utilities and companies, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, DOUGLAS COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

That a service charge and check refusal schedule should be established as follows:

A minimum charge of \$5.00 per check or such sum in addition as may be shown in actual cost to the District for returned checks from the bank shall be assessed against the person offering said check. Further, upon the second N.S.F. check or returned check from the same customer within any twelve month period, then such person shall be required to make payment by cash, certified check or money order thereafter.

ADOPTED this 22nd day of July, 1975, by the Board of Commissioners of East Wenatchee Water District at a regular meeting thereof.
