

RESOLUTION NO. 143

RESOLUTION INCREASING METER INSTALLATION CHARGES

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined through an examination of the books and records pertaining to the installation of water meters, that the current rates for the installation of same is not consistent with the actual cost, and

WHEREAS, the District has a duty to maintain a cost basis for services performed and such services are to be non-discriminatory to all of its customers, and it is apparent that the basic rate for installation of meters should be raised, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, DOUGLAS COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:


That the base rate for meter installation of a 5/8" water meter shall be raised to the sum of \$250.00 beginning the 4th day of May, 1976, and that the installation charge for larger size meters shall be on a direct cost basis according to the actual manhours, machine hours, and material used in installing said meters.
