

RESOLUTION NO. 159
RAISING PETTY CASH LIMIT

WHEREAS, the Petty Cash requirements for the ordinary transactions of business for the District has substantially and seriously increased, and

WHEREAS, the present fund is not sufficient or adequate to meet the current needs, and the Office Manager has recommended an increase to One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington, that the Office Manager is hereby authorized to increase the Petty Cash limit to One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars immediately, to remain at said increase until further action may be taken and subject to vouchering for replenishment on a monthly basis.
