

RESOLUTION NO. 160


DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING SALE

WHEREAS, the Pace radio equipment now owned and utilized by the District personnel is no longer capable of meeting the extended area requirements, and

WHEREAS, said Pace equipment has been causing a serious radio channel override onto the Washington State Patrol frequencies, and such equipment must be replaced by radio equipment with substantially different capabilities and channels, rendering said Pace equipment as surplus property to the District; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington, that the Pace radio equipment now owned and operated by the District is hereby declared to be surplus, and the Manager is authorized and directed to call for bids to dispose of said surplus equipment.
