AUTHORIZING LEGAL COUNSEL TO INVESTIGATE PACE RADIOS


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District having purchased Pace Radio Equipment for their mobile units, and

WHEREAS, the District has experienced a great difficulty with said equipment causing a serious radio channel override onto the Washington State Patrol frequencies and to further substantiate that said Pace Radio was possibly defective as indicated in a letter dated March 23, 1977, by Don Peltz, President of Central Communication System, Wenatchee, Washington 98801, and

WHEREAS, the District deemed it necessary to purchase another brand of radios and has since found the present brand to be satisfactory, NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS hereby authorizes our present legal counsel to investigate the possibility of seeking recovery of funds from Pace Radio or their distributor for defective equipment.
