


RESOLUTION NO. 191

PURCHASE OF INTEREST BEARING WARRANT


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District is currently unable to pay all of the warrants issued, and


WHEREAS, the District believes it is in the best interests of the District that it retain a good credit record and continue to pay its bills as they come due, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the East Wenatchee Water District will issue interest bearing warrants in the total sum of \$36,000.00; said warrants to bear interest at an annual rate of 4.5%, to be issued to the District's bankers, Rainier Bank of Waterville, Washington, to be payable on demand in 90 days from the date funds are advanced to the District.
