

RESOLUTION NO. 207


AUTHORIZING MANAGER TO ATTEND
MEETING OF DOUGLAS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has had problems of unauthorized persons and various contractors obtaining water from various fire hydrants within the District, and

WHEREAS, the District's attorney has drafted a proposal to eliminate such practice in the future and has discussed the matter with the prosecuting attorney, and


WHEREAS, the prosecuting attorney has suggested that the manager attend the next County Commissioners meeting to present said problem to the Commissioners so that a proposed ordinance may be instituted to eliminate such practice in the future.
