

RESOLUTION NO. 213
SALE OF SURPLUS EQUIPMENT


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District complied with RCW 57.08.050 in disposing of surplus equipment, and

WHEREAS, the district received the following bids from individuals: Lyle Detillion - \$600 on 1971 Chevrolet pickup, \$200 on 1971 Ford Torino Station Wagon, \$400 on 1974 Datsun pickup, and \$500 on 1973 Chevrolet El Camino; Paul Kunkel - \$1,227 on 1974 Datsun pickup; Jerry R. Baker - \$1,310 on 1974 Datsun pickup; E. J. Flaherty - \$1,788 on 1974 Datsun pickup, and \$1,700 on El Camino; John B. Wood - \$1,650 on 1974 Datsun pickup; Andrea J. Mezezon - \$1,205 on 1974 Datsun pickup; William Feiten - \$1,005 on 1974 Datsun pickup; and Dale Gwinn - \$200 on 1955 Chevrolet dump truck.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the highest bidder was Lyle Detillion on the 1971 Chevrolet pickup, E. J. Flaherty on the 1974 Datsun pickup and the 1973 El Camino, and Dale Gwinn on the 1955 Chevrolet dump truck.

WHEREAS, only one bid in the amount of \$200 was received on the 1971 Torino station wagon, the district reserved the right to reject said bid.
