

RESOLUTION No. 243

AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF TELEMETER

WHEREAS, the District having experienced a great amount of difficulty in the past year with the present telemeter, and

WHEREAS, said telemeter has on several occasions failed to perform its normal function in allowing reservoirs to be pumped dry as results of various pumps failing to operate properly, and

WHEREAS, present telemeter has been in use by the District since 1961 and it is very difficult to obtain parts for, and

WHEREAS, the District has been paying out a great amount of money in overtime to its employees the past six months, and it would be deemed in the best interest to the District to replace the present one with a new system, and

WHEREAS, the Manager has determined that two firms in the State of Washington sells said item and having received a written quote from Stead and Baggerly, Inc. out of Redmond, Washington in the amount of \$52,416.00 and a verbal quote of \$55,000 to \$65,000 from Sparling Company, Bellevue, Wa. and

WHEREAS, the District has contacted the State Auditor and was informed that this item did not require that we obtain bids as it was a part of our daily equipment that is essential in our everyday use.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Manager is authorized to proceed in purchasing said telemeter from Stead and Baggerly, Inc. on the quote of \$52,416.00.
