

RESOLUTION NO. 259

AUTHORIZING RATE STUDY BY DISTRICT'S ENGINEERING FIRM


WHEREAS, the District having invested a substantial amount of money to reconstruct our accounting system as recommended by the State Auditor in the 1976 audit, and

WHEREAS, the District has now completed revising its entire accounting system, and wants to determine its position financially, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners are contemplating a rate increase in March of 1979, to all water users, but before said rate increase is to be initiated, it is believed to be in the best interest of the District as well as the rate payers to have a rate study compiled so we will know if the District is complying with the proper covenants and coverage as called for in Resolution No. 146 dated July 13, 1976. Said rate study will determine the amount of increase that should be initiated, if any.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT authorizes the engineering firm of Forsgren, Perkins engineering compile a rate study.
