SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION NO. 221 -- "ESTABLISHING FEES FOR FIRE HYDRANTS"

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 221, the East Wenatchee Water District Board of Commissioners established a set fee for the installation of a 4" and 6" fire hydrant respectively, and


WHEREAS, said rates have not been able to fairly and accurately reflect the increase costs of doing business, and

WHEREAS, it appears reasonable and necessary to establish a new formula that is consistent with the actual costs involved in accordance with the District's overhead.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that all future fire hydrant installations, whether it be by request of an individual or a developer, will be installed at cost plus 20% in commensurate with the hourly rate schedule as previously adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or rate policies inconsistent with this Resolution No. 276 are hereby revoked.
