

Resolution No. 283

INCREASING MULTIPLE UNIT WATER RATES & AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 163

WHEREAS, a survey of the East Wenatchee Water District customers indicates that there are a substantial number of multi-unit dwellings being served through a single meter, and,

WHEREAS, multiple units shall be defined as duplexes, triplexes, four-plexes, apartments, condominiums, mobile home parks or other structures with more than one dwelling unit.

WHEREAS, the present charging system call/s for the basic rate, plus one-half the basic rate for each additional unit being served off of said meter, and,


WHEREAS, the Manager having conducted an extensive survey of other districts, towns and cities as to rate structures and consumption has reviewed the alternatives available to the District, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners having thoroughly reviewed the present rate structure with management, deem it to be in the best interest of the District to retain the present basic rate and increase the cost to multiple unit users so as to standardize the rates throughout the District,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, that effective January 1, 1980, the basic water charges for all multiple units shall be increased from the present one-half basic rate to the full basic rate;

FURTHER, an additional 600 cubic feet of consumption will be allowed to all multiple units beyond the first meter each billing period.
