

RESOLUTION NO. 286

Authorizing Purchase of Computer for District Use

WHEREAS, the present computer owned by the District is not adequate to serve the District's needs due to an unusual and unanticipated growth throughout the District over the past three years, and,

WHEREAS, the manager and accountant have discussed with three different firms regarding a machine that will best serve the District's present needs as well as those of the future, and,

WHEREAS, the District must spend considerable monies to update the present machine as well as the purchase of new ledger cards for billing purposes, and,

WHEREAS, having carefully reviewed all aspects and received a quote of approximately \$40,000 from N.C.R. and a quote of \$34,125.00 including sales tax and installation from Program Service Center, Bainbridge Island, Washington, it is believed that the Dolphin Computer of Program Service Center, will best serve the District's needs now, as well as those of the future.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington, that the Manager is hereby authorized to proceed with the purchase of the Dolphin Computer at the cost set forth above.
