Authorizing tips or gratuities for services


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has not in the past established by resolution, a policy concerning reimbursement for tips or gratuities, and

WHEREAS, the Manager has consulted with the State Examiner relative to this matter and learned that a recent ruling has been rendered by the State Attorney General that this practice is permissible, but not to exceed fifteen percent (15%), and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the District as well as its employees from time to time find it necessary to attend seminars, schools or other business related matters that may be authorized by the Board of Commissioners, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the District to establish by resolution a policy that will legally permit such practice as authorized by the State Attorney General.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington hereby authorize its employees to give tips or gratuities not to exceed 15% while engaged on business as authorized by the Board of Commissioners. Such tips and gratuities must be verified by written receipt.
