
WHEREAS, said truck will replace the car, 1972 - 4-door Ford sedan, being presently used by the Superintendent daily for field use, and

WHEREAS, the District has no further use for said car and deem it to be in the best interest of the District to dispose of same; also, declaring the following as surplus equipment and deem it necessary to dispose of said articles:

- 2- Lawn mowers
- 1- Brute steam cleaner
- 1- Pickup tool box for 48" bed
- 1- IBM Selectric typewriter (1971)
- 1- IBICO 1202 10 key adding machine
- 1- NCR 399 Computer, 8V, memory with two drives, mag ledger card storage
- 5- Ledger card trays with roller carts


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District hereby declare the above named items plus 1972 car be surplus equipment and further authorizes the Manager to call for bids and dispose of same according to the statutes set forth.
