

RESOLUTION NO. 307

AUTHORIZING NUMBER OF SERVICES TO CONNECT TO VARIOUS SIZE WATER METERS

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has a large number of multi-unit dwellings now serving off of a single unit water meter, such as duplexes, triplexes, four-plexes, apartments, condominiums, mobile home parks and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the District is losing revenue in some areas where the present meter is undersized for the number of dwellings it now serves and,

WHEREAS, the District in the past, has permitted the number of dwellings to be served off of a single sized meter according to the American Water Works Association standards and,


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deem it to be in the best interest of the District to standardize its' procedures, due to the demand and usage of water in certain areas of the District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that effective April 27th, 1981, the following number of water hook-ups will be permitted to serve from various size meters:

1. One-inch meter (1"), four (4) units will be permitted to serve from this meter as 20 G.P.M. (gallons per minute) can flow through this meter and still maintain its' maximum efficiency.
2. One and a half-inch meter (1½). Twelve units will be permitted to serve from this meter as 40 G.P.M. (gallons per minutes) can flow through this meter and still maintain its' maximum efficiency.
3. Two-inch meter (2"). Eighteen (18) units will be permitted to serve from this meter as 60 G.P.M. (gallons per minute) can flow through this meter and still maintain its' maximum efficiency.
4. Three-inch meter (3"). This installation shall consist of a Turbine Meter and up to one-hundred (100) units will be permitted to serve off of this meter as 500 G.P.M. (gallons per minute) can flow through said meter and still maintain its' maximum efficiency.

The foregoing rules will apply only where water mains do not front dwellings as outlined and all meter installations shall be placed on County or City right-of-ways.

ADOPTED, this 4th day of May 1981, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
