

RESOLUTION NO. 308

AUTHORIZING RELOCATION OF FILL STATION AND ESTABLISHING BULK WATER RATES


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has for a number of years, permitted the use of a fill station on Valley Mall Parkway for the purpose of filling spray tanks for farmers, the City Of East Wenatchee, Douglas County, Douglas County Sewer District and various contractors in their normal or everyday use and,

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has not been reimbursed by the various users a fair amount to justify the continued use in it's present location and,


WHEREAS, it has been established that the present rate of \$0.50 per one thousand (1,000) gallons of water hauled is not equitable to the district and a new rate should be re-established for it's continued operation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that effective June 1st, 1981, the minimum charge on hauled water shall be one dollar (\$1.00) and each thousand gallons shall be one dollar (\$1.00) until which time the Board of Commissioners establish a new rate.

ADOPTED, this 8th day of June 1981, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
