WHEREAS, the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT has previously established by Resolution, a Small Works Roster under R.C.W. 57.08.050 and,


WHEREAS, the Small Works Roster is comprised of contractors who have specifically requested their name be on this roster for the purpose of being able to submit a bid for projects that fall within the guidelines of R.C.W. 57.08.050 and,

WHEREAS, the Water District did receive two (2) bids to install approximately 750 feet of 6" pipe on Lyle Avenue, which were opened at 10:30 A.M. on October 5th, 1984, at the office of the East Wenatchee Water District from Stubbs Excavation and B.A. Wilson in the amounts of \$4,547.78 and \$4,932.58 respectively and,


WHEREAS, having reviewed the bids and the necessary bonds with the District's legal counsel to determine that both bids were in compliance with the plans and specifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT of Douglas County, WA that the low bid in the amount of \$4,547.78 be awarded to Stubbs Excavation Company.
