

RESOLUTION NO. 342

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 261 - - - STEEL PIPE FROM WATER METER TO DWELLING


WHEREAS, a resolution was adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District on February 5th, 1979 whereby only copper or galvanized pipe would be permitted to be installed from the water meter to the dwelling and,

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Commissioners, on January 23rd, 1985 amended their resolution and adopted the Uniform Plumbing Code, Title XIV to include Polybutylene Pipe to be used with the further exception of the first twenty feet of pipe connected to and extending from a water meter of an approved water purveyor shall be only of a metallic material and,


WHEREAS, the Water District believes it to be in the best interest of the District to standardize it's policy with the County so when a water meter is purchased, the customer will be fully informed of the policy he must adhere to,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County Washington, hereby amends Resolution No. 261 to include Polybutylene Pipe to be used, provided that the first twenty (20) feet from the water meter shall be of metallic material.
