**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION TO INSTALL A NEW WATER MAIN ON N W FIR STREET
WITH WATER DISTRICT PERSONNEL**

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has encountered several leaks with the existing four inch water main on N W Fir Street because of its' time in service and,


WHEREAS, said location of water main has been a controversial subject for a number of years between an individual who own property in the adjacent area and the Douglas County Dept. of Public Works and,

WHEREAS, additional right-of-way has now been obtained from various property owners to the West of the existing controversial right-of-way, thereby eliminating any doubt that a new water main installed will not be an issue between the pending lawsuit of the existing property owner and the County and,

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Public Works Department is preparing to widen the road so that tax payors can better be served in the County's day to day maintenance operation and,


WHEREAS, the County Engineer has written a letter to the Water District, dated August 23rd, 1988, requesting that we proceed in relocating the water main, as well as all existing water meters, by September 1st, '88, (of which a copy of said letter is attached and made a part thereof) so the County can construct and re-furbish the new road prior to winter.
