

RESOLUTION NO. 375

AWARDING BID FOR INSTALLATION OF 14" WATER LINE ON 5th STREET


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District having complied with R.C.W. 57.08.050 in calling for bids to install approximately 1,100 feet of 14" ductile iron water main on 5th Street in the District's distribution system and,

WHEREAS, the District having received three bids for said project; Namely: Long Construction in the amount of \$36,729.50; Selland Construction in the amount of \$33,814.55 and A. L. Pipkin Construction in the amount of \$27,754.09 - all of the above were excluding sales tax and all included bid bonds. The District's consulting engineer's estimate was in the amount of \$33,771.50.

WHEREAS, the manager having reviewed the contract documents with the engineer and the District's legal counsel for technicalities and found that there were no apparent problems as called for in the bid specifications.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District that the low bid in the amount of \$27,754.09 is hereby awarded to A. L. Pipkin Construction.
