

RESOLUTION NO. 377

Amending Resolution #309 and authorizing a Connection Charge to the sale of all water meters.

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District adopted the above resolution on June 22, 1981 authorizing a Plant Investment Fee on the sale of all water meters and,

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature passed substitute Senate Bill #6013 effective July 23, 1989, whereby a Water or Sewer District is entitled to charge for a customer to connect to that system and

WHEREAS, the Connection Charge shall be the pro-rata share of the cost of the existing facilities and planned future improvements for the next ten years and other directly attributable costs borne by the district (but those costs shall not include portions of the system which have been contributed to the district) and,


WHEREAS, the district has computed the pro-rata share as required by statement, and said computation requires an amendment to Resolution 309, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, that a Plant Investment Fee is established as follows on the sale of all water meters:
