

RESOLUTION NO. 378

ESTABLISHING METER SIZE FOR DOMESTIC WATER USE AT
FANCHER HEIGHTS ADDITION

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has been deeded a domestic water system installed in a development within the Water District boundary, known as Fancher Heights Addition and,

WHEREAS, all water mains and other apparatus related to said system was installed by the developers to the Water District specifications, as well as engineered by the District's consulting engineer and,


WHEREAS, the fifty five lot residential development has no irrigation water to help irrigate or sprinkle the large lots and,

WHEREAS, the system was installed knowing that irrigation was not available and larger pipes were installed to facilitate using a one inch meter for each lot to meet the required demand of water consumption and,

WHEREAS, any water meter less than a one inch will cause excessive wear and overtax the capabilities of the meter, resulting with inaccurate consumption readings.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that effective immediately, all water meters installed in the Fancher Heights Addition will be a minimum of one inch in size.
