

RESOLUTION NO. 382

AUTHORIZING BASE RATE INCREASE FOR WATER USAGE

WHEREAS, the present base rate for water service supplies to single family residence, multiple dwellings, mobile home courts and commercial users of the East Wenatchee Water District has not changed since May 1st, 1978 and,

WHEREAS, the District's engineer submitted a Five Year Comprehensive Plan to the Board of Commissioners in the fall of 1989 and the District has from time to time reviewed the Plan necessary to serve the immediate and future needs within the district and foreseeable areas where deficiencies exist within the District boundaries and,


WHEREAS, the existing rates are not adequate to address the betterments and improvements as called for in the Comprehensive Plan, as well as meet the bond payments and debt service of the District and meet the increased population to serve, its present as well as future customers and,

WHEREAS, the District has just purchased additional property adjacent to the 19th Street Wells and will drill two new wells for both present and future use, which will cost the District approximately \$275,000 and this further substantiates why it is prudent to initiate a rate increase at this time to adjust our revenues to allow for future expansion.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that effective January 1st, 1991, the base rate for 600 cubic feet of water consumed will be \$8.00 per month.
